THREE ADDITIONAL POSTGRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAMMES- LATE WINDOW APPLICATIONS FOR 2026/2027 ACADEMIC YEAR

MUHAS is pleased to inform the public and call for applications to three recently accredited postgraduate degree programmes for the 2026/2027 academic year in addition to the programs in the ongoing call for late window applications.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

All applications shall be processed and submitted online through a portal accessible on the MUHAS website (<https://pgoas.muhas.ac.tz>). Applications submitted in hard copies shall not be processed.

APPLICATION FEE:

The application fee is TSH 100,000/= for Tanzanian applicants and US\$ 50 for foreign applicants, paid to the University.

This can be paid via Mobile Money (for local applicants, as per instructions on the application portal) or directly to MUHAS NBC Bank Account (for foreign applicants). The NBC bank account details for use by foreign applicants are listed below;

ATTACHMENTS:

Applicants shall be required to upload and submit clear scanned copies of the following documents;

1. An up-to-date, detailed curriculum vitae.
2. Copies of ordinary level secondary education, advanced level secondary education, undergraduate certificates, and academic transcripts.
3. Internship certificate (MUST be provided as appropriate).
4. Birth certificate.
5. A letter from the employer showing readiness to release the applicant for studies.
6. For foreign applicants, receipt of payment of the application fee.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

1. All applicants must be proficient in written and spoken English.
2. Successful applicants shall be required to submit original copies of certificates and transcripts for verification at the time of admission.
3. MUHAS has three campuses: Upanga (Muhimbili), Mloganzila, and Kigoma. Therefore, students selected to join the various postgraduate programmes could be assigned to clinical rotations across the three campuses.

DEADLINE: The deadline for submitting applications is **Friday, 31st July 2026**.

THE THREE RECENTLY ACCREDITED DEGREE PROGRAMMES ARE:

1. Master of Science in Bioinformatics (2 years)
2. Master of Science in Phytopharmaceuticals and Natural Medicines (2 years)
3. Master of Science in Radiation Therapy (2 years)

Eligibility Criteria

MSc. Bioinformatics

First degree in Bioinformatics, Data Science, Medicine, Pharmacy, Biochemistry, Molecular Biology, Biotechnology, Dental Surgery, Nursing, Microbiology, Biochemistry, Biomedical Engineering, Medical Laboratory Sciences, Veterinary Medicine, Genetics, Botany, Zoology, Computer Science, Information technology, Mathematics, Statistics, Biostatistics, Clinical Epidemiology or equivalent degree from a recognized institution with a minimum cumulative GPA OF 2.7. Background in biological sciences will be given priority

MSc. Phytopharmaceuticals and Natural Medicines

Bachelor of Pharmacy (Minimum of B pass in Pharmacognosy), Pharmaceutical sciences, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology or a related field with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.7 from a recognized Institution **OR** Postgraduate Diploma in any relevant field with an average of “B” or a minimum GPA of 3.0. Certificate of completion of internship or certificate of full registration by the Pharmacy council of Tanzania.

MSc. Radiation Therapy

Bachelor's degree in Diagnostic and Therapeutic Radiography with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.7 from a recognized institution. Certificate of completion of an internship. Registered or eligible to be registered and licensed by a professional board from the country of origin at the time of application
